### **Update on Our Beneficiary Projects**

#### **The Catch Project**

I visited the Catch Project premises on Wednesday to have a last look at the makeshift library. It was clear that they needed an upgrade for it to function as a library. They have about 4 bookshelves but most of their books I understand were still lying on the floor in the coordinator's office. Their intention is to have all their books which had been so generously donated by some schools, in one place where the children could easily access them. Also, there is still enough space in the prefabricated building to accommodate more shelves and even some reading desks. Our club through our AMNEF Game will make and donate more shelves to the centre. I believe that doing this directly ourselves rather than buying already made shelves from the shop will be more cost effective. We hope to deliver these before the end of March 2023.

#### **The King's Children Home**

I also visited this home on Saturday and had a chat with Mrs. King who runs the home. I explained the difficulties we face in trying to build them an ablution facility like we had hoped. Like I indicated in my last report, constructing the sewerage for the proposed ablution will require permission from the municipal authorities, will take time and will cost a lot more money than our budget would allow. Mrs. King understood the problems and will be happy if we could deal with other pressing problems at the home. She asked for time to consult with her board before she tells us what else we should do for them that is within our budget.

The Nationals are coming up next week in Bloemfontein. I wish the Border Team safe travels and a successful campaign.

Him and Dale Heyes started the Compleat Golfer magazine, and he was the editor for a number of years.

A stickler for the rules of golf, he became one of South Africa's experts on the Rules of Golf, but also understood why the Rules were composed in the way they were.

His favourite saying when he lectured on Golf rules “you may have nearest point of relief not nicest point of relief”.

The past few years he lectured at the Golf Management Campus.
