VC's Report September 2023

A successful fundraising event for the AMEF was held on the 27 August 2023 at West Bank Golf Club. A total of 40 golfers participated in the five- club fundraising event and R5 580.00 was raised towards the selected project for the Border Nomads Golf Club 2023.

The upcoming events namely Night Golf fundraising event on 9th September 2023 at Python Park Mashie Golf and Dr Leyton Mngxaso Annual Charity Golf Day on 22nd September 2023 at Olivewood serve as build up events towards the Main AMEF Charity Golf day that will be held on the 15th October 2023 at East London Golf Club.

The total income that has been generated as of the last game in September 2023 for Andrew Mentis is R17 379.00 and this includes a variety of items ranging from monthly allocations e.g. raffle, birdie bash and other initiatives such as chip in competitions and five club fundraising events. The figure exclude expenditure incurred for other fundraising events on the pipeline estimated at R10 307.00 and leaving a balance of R7 072.00 available to the beneficiary at this stage. The target set for funds to be raised for the beneficiary is R100 000.00 in the current year. The fundraising campaign has started with AMEF committee members approaching various potential sponsors for the project as well as the support to our main event on the 15th October 2023.

The selected beneficiary (Canaan Care Centre) has experienced an unfortunate situation as reported by the former centre manager that it has undergone liquidation on the 15 August 2023 due to financial difficulties. I am currently, working on replacing the beneficiary with other potential projects I have received and am busy doing site visits and validation and these will be presented to the committee on the scheduled meeting on 8 September 2023 for adoption and onward submission to national for approval.

The incident will necessitate the review of the documentation shared with potential sponsors as well as the marketing material that still carry the name of the original beneficiary. The work on engaging potential sponsors is progressing well and the commitment and pledges made by members for the main event is appreciated. We want to implore our members to be our ambassadors and get a word out there for people to contribute to the good cause that nomads are doing and get their participation on this noble cause of helping those who are less fortunate than ourselves.

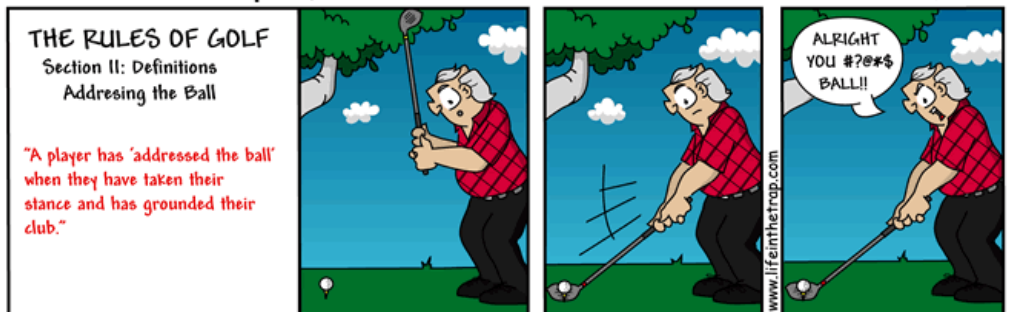

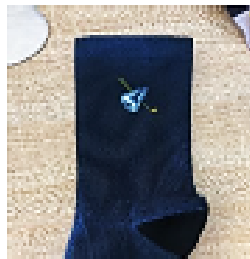

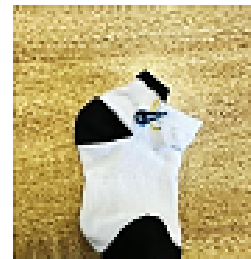
