“The SA Amateurs”

The Proudfoot Trophy has a terrific history and is named after the second winner of the SA Amateur way back in 1893, Doug Proudfoot, who won 8 SA Amateurs in a row.

The Proudfoot Trophy is given to the winner of the two qualifying rounds for the SA Amateur.

There are some amazing names on that trophy. In the first ten years leading up to the Second World War, **Clarence Olander** won it three times. **Bobby Locke** and **Jack Watermeyer** both won it twice. Denis Hutchinson also won it twice and my brother and I were both winners, as were **Mark McNulty**, **Tony Johnstone**, **Hugh Baiocchi**, **Trevor Immelman**, and more recently **Brandon Stone**, **Luca Fillippi** and **Jovan Rebula**.

The winners have gotten younger and younger but this year's winner, **Ben Weber** from East London, broke all the records for age when at only 14 years, he shot 69 and a bogey-free 66 on Royal Johannesburg's East Course to win by one at 9-under 135.

Sixty-four players then teed it up in the matchplay which was won by Scotland's **Gregor Graham** who beat the SA Strokeplay champion **Jordan Burnand** 4&2 in the 36-hole final.

In the two semi-final matches, Gregor Graham beat Pearce Lewin 4&2 while Jordan Burnand beat Ben Weber 5&3.

In the ladies event, last year's SA Amateur winner, **Kyra van Kan** from Pretoria, made it a double when she won the **SA Women's Amateur Strokeplay** at Modderfontein.

She shot rounds of 71-67-70 to win in wire-to-wire style, six clear of **Kesha Louw**, on 8-under par.”

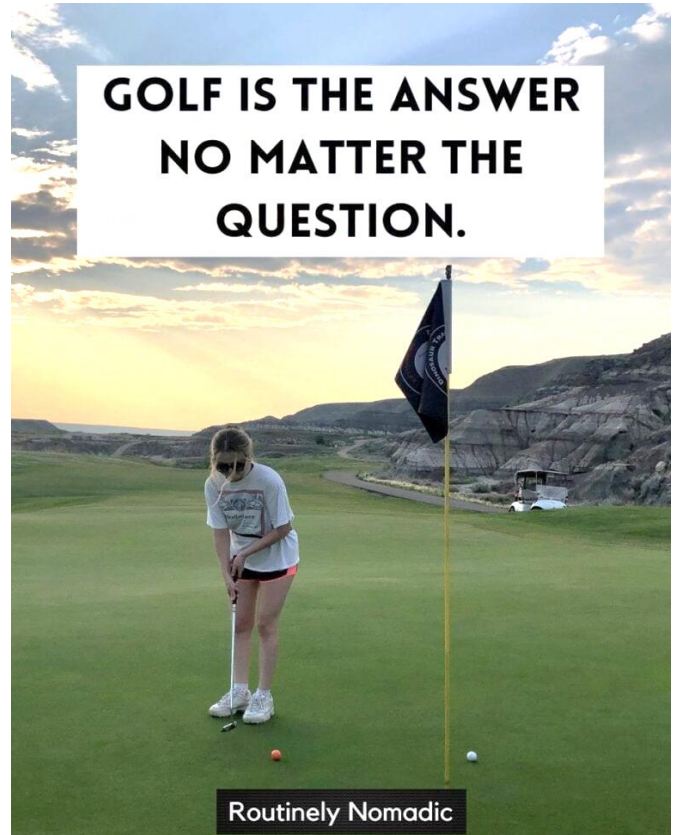

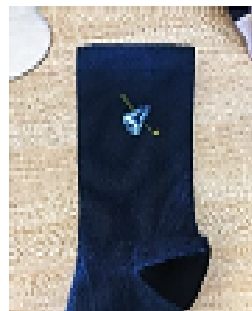

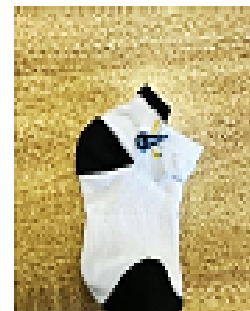
